Consent for laser hair reduction. Laser energy targets pigment in the hair to reduce growth over a series of treatments. Most guests require 8-10 treatments; laser hair reduction is reduction, not guaranteed permanent removal. All laser work happens inside laser season, September 15 to April 15.

What to Know

- ☐ Treatment feels like quick snaps with warmth; redness and bumps around follicles are normal for a day or two.
- ☐ Blistering, burns, and temporary or (rarely) lasting pigment change are possible, and the risk rises sharply with recent sun, tanning, self-tanner, or photosensitizing medication.
- ☐ Laser is not effective on gray or white hair, and candidacy depends on hair and skin tone.
- ☐ The area must be shaved before treatment, and not waxed or tweezed between sessions.

I Confirm That

- ☐ I have had no sun or tanning-bed exposure and no self-tanner on the treatment area in the past 2 weeks, and I will avoid both for 2 weeks after.
- ☐ I am not taking antibiotics or other photosensitizing medication (or I have disclosed them and been cleared).
- ☐ I have disclosed all medications including blood thinners.
- ☐ I understand the treatment schedule matters and results depend on completing the series.

For your safety, tell us about all medications and supplements (including aspirin, ibuprofen, fish oil, antibiotics, and retinoids), skin conditions, allergies, recent or planned sun or tanning-bed exposure, self-tanner use, pregnancy or nursing, and recent cosmetic procedures. Undisclosed conditions and medications are the most common cause of poor outcomes.

Results vary with skin type, age, hormones, health, home care, and consistency with the treatment plan. Honest work is promised; specific outcomes are not guaranteed.
